

5/20/22 MAFH Update:

Parents and campers, thanks again for your patience as we move closer to our camp season. We will continue to monitor our local and state guidelines and prepare for the lowest risk residential camp experience for all campers, families, and staff!

The [MAFH Covid-19 Rules](#) are updated to show current requirements for the 2022 season.

My medical staff wants to be as prepared as possible to know our participants as best we can prior to your camp session check-in date. We are asking for the following information so we are better prepared to manage each medical concern that may arise at our resident camp. MEDICAL INFORMATION will be kept private and confidential.

Please include the following with pages 3 / 4 from the camper [Additional Information Packet](#). Pages 3 and 4 are due by June 15<sup>th</sup> or ASAP if registering after that date. Please contact us with any delays in securing information, we understand not all documents may be available by this date. **Each camper does need a recent physical examination** clearing them for participation. (each camper must have a completed physical within the calendar year of your camp session).

**If your child was diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 6 months,** please have your child visit their pediatrician for a post-illness visit prior to camp and *please send a note from your child's doctor indicating that they are cleared to participate in the physical activity of a resident four-night sports camp.* Or if you have had a physical – which must be dated **AFTER** the athlete had **COVID** with the physician clearing them for full participation.

If your child has a medical diagnosis that is considered **high-risk** or that could put them at increased risk of complications with COVID-19, please have your child evaluated by their provider and *please send a note from your child's doctor indicating that they are cleared to participate in the physical activity of a resident four-night sports camp.*

If you **choose** and/or can be partially or fully vaccinated by camp, please upload a copy of your Covid-19 vaccination card. This allows us to follow guidelines necessary to isolate and/or quarantine participants, if we have covid symptoms and/or a positive case. A few parents have stated in their health forms that their child is fully vaccinated, we will need a copy of the official card to keep with medical forms.

## Accessing your registration portal/dashboard

All campers need to log into their account and click on "Complete Task" under Incomplete Tasks on their dashboard (see first image below). Once you click that link, it will take you to a page where you can upload each task. The status of each task will be visible and then two options to upload their file (see second image below). Campers can take a picture or scan the item before doing this process and then follow uploading actions. Each task item will need to be uploaded separately to complete the task. If you have more than one page per task (ex, additional medical notes to add to page 4 health history), you will need to scan those pages as one PDF document.

If you need to make a payment or pay balance, go to dashboard to make a payment on your member account and click "Make Payment" (see first image below). Full payment is due by June 15<sup>th</sup>. Please contact the [director](#) ASAP with any questions, if payment is late, and/or you will not be attending MAFH camp.
